



IMPORTANT REMINDER NOTICE

UNIFORMS

Grading is complete. Referees have been directed to enforce uniform penalties for any violations. Teams were given the grading period as a time to have these issues sorted. From Round 6 all violations will result in a five point penalty for seniors and two point penalties for junior competitions, awarded to the opposition team at half time.

Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES is a player allowed to play with pockets in their shorts. If a player does not have appropriate playing shorts without any pockets, they WILL NOT be permitted to take the court and play.

All players are required to wear a team uniform consisting of same colored tops for each team member. Likewise with bottoms, all teams must be wearing the same colored shorts. Tops and shorts do not have to match, but must be the same color for each team member. Please Note: Navy Blue and Black are considered different colors.

All players must remove objects such as watches/jewellery (taping of facial jewellery is not permitted under FIBA Rules) that may be dangerous to other players. A wedding band may be worn, but must be appropriately taped.

T-shirts (the same dominant color as the team's shirts), compressions sleeves and compression stockings may be worn as long as a medical certificate is provided to the Referee Shift Supervisor.

WALKOVERS

By contacting the administration office 48 hours prior to your game and notify us you are unable to play, the Notified Walkover Fines are \$33.00. If you fail to notify us, the Un-notified Walkover Fines = \$55.00

Walkover Fines must be paid the following week at your next game.

Failure to do so will forfeit any ladder points for games played while the fine is outstanding.

FIRST AID

First Aid is the responsibility of each team. Ice can be obtained from the canteen or referees room.

QUALIFICATIONS

It is the team's responsibility to check qualification lists. These are displayed on the notice boards approximately seven weeks prior to finals, and can also be found on the Waverley website.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

REGISTRATION AND QUALIFICATION INFORMATION

TEAM REGISTRATIONS

By completing the team registration form and submitting with payment, all players listed become registered members. Players not listed on the original form must register at their first game.

NEW PLAYER REGISTRATIONS

Additional players joining a team during the season must register their **FULL NAME** and details on the 'LiveScore Courtside Monitors.' In addition, new players must complete the '**Senior Player Registration Form**' found in the foyer or the website and submit to the cashier's booth with payment.

A \$6.00 Registration/Insurance fee must be paid to the cashier with the individual player registration form. Players permanently withdrawing from a team during the season can be replaced by another player and that player's registration can be transferred to the replacement new player, however you must advise us.

ILLEGAL AND UNREGISTERED PLAYERS

Failing to enter new player details on the LiveScore Monitors, and playing new players under withdrawn or absent player's names renders players **ILLEGAL**

Playing people under another person's name, or playing unregistered players is an offence and **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED**.

If teams are found to be playing members illegally, game results will be altered so the offending team will lose that match and points and qualifications will be removed. Repeat offenders will be suspended.

Ignoring this rule is putting players at risk! If you play uninsured, you are not covered for injury, physiotherapy, and loss of wages etc from the stadiums insurance group, Horsell.

If an illegal or suspended player takes the court, this will result in a **REPORT** and tribunal hearings. All referee supervisors have the authority to ask for identification if a team queries this rule. Referee supervisors on each night will report to the office any offenders.

FINALS QUALIFICATIONS

Players listed on the LIVESCORE monitors will qualify for the game they are listed. Teams must only list players present and in uniform at the game. Referees will check playing lists at half time and conclusion of matches.

To be eligible to qualify for finals all players must compete in eight (8) of the season's fixture games. Players replacing other players during the season do not accumulate replaced player's game total.

Teams are responsible for checking noticeboards and website for eligibility of players and for team final placing and if you are scheduled to play in finals irrespective of position on ladder.

Any queries must be directed to the office seven days or more prior to the Semi Final. No queries will be dealt with during finals.
