



## COMPETITION LADDERS

### WBA JUNIOR AND SENIOR DOMESTIC COMPETITIONS

#### LADDER POINTS

Ladder positions are determined using the following formula:

WIN	= 3 POINTS
DRAW	= 2 POINTS
LOSS	= 1 POINT
FORFEIT	= 0 POINTS
BYES	= 3 POINTS

In cases where a team gives a walkover and forfeits a game, the result will be recorded as a 20-0 win to the non-forfeiting team.

#### LADDER POSITIONS

At the conclusion of a regular season if two teams are equal on ladder points, the position will be determined by the team with the most overall percentage.

Percentage is calculated by the number of total scores made against the total number of scores made against the team, the number is then multiplied by 100.

PP% is not used in WBA competitions. This is an alternative way of calculating the amount games a team has won against the total number of games played. Due to the impact of BYEs, grading changes and late entries into the competition, this system is not practical for WBA ladders

#### ABANDONED GAMES

Abandoned games refer to situations where a game is unable to continue due to circumstances beyond the control of either team.

Games abandoned before half time is signaled will be recorded as a 2-2 draw.

If a game is abandoned after half time is signaled, the score at the time of abandonment will be recorded as the final result.

#### OTHER NOTES REGARDING LADDERS

Ladders are not used or displayed in Under 8 Competitions.

Senior grading games count towards regular season ladders. Junior grading games are not counted towards regular season ladders.

Teams entering competitions late will generally be credited with losses for each game missed.
