



JUNIOR DOMESTIC FILL IN PLAYERS

FILLING IN FOR A HIGHER AGE GROUP (Under 10 – Under 18)

- Teams may bring players up from lower age groups to fill in.
- A fill-in player may drop down a maximum of two sections from their registered age group.
 - E.g. A player registered in under 10 section 3 may play under 12 section 1-5 and any under 14 section.
 - E.g. 2: A player registered in under 12 section 7 may play any section of under 14 and older age groups.
 - E.g.3: A player registered in under 12 section 1 can not play in under 14 section 4 or below but can play in any section of under 16
- Players can not play for more than one team in the same age group at any time during the season
 - E.g. A player register in under 10 section 4 can not play under 10 section 2 in the same season unless they are filling in for a game and have not played for their team on the same day.
- Except for Under eight teams in the following circumstances;

FILL IN PLAYERS FOR UNDER 8 TEAMS

- Teams may use players from other under eight teams from the same club. However, it may only do so if:
 - There are fewer than six players available for a game,
 - the additional player(s) will not give the team an unfair advantage,
 - and the player(s) has only played one other game on game day.

FILLING IN FOR A DIFFERENT COMPETITION

- There are two separate WBA junior domestic competitions:
 - **Boys** U/8, U/10, U/12, U/14, U/16 and U/18
 - **Girls** U/8, U/10, U/12, U/14, U/16 and U/18
- A player cannot play for two different clubs in the same competition.
- A player in the Girls competition can fill in for a team in the Boys competition for their Home Club provided they qualify for the age group, all other fill-in rules apply.
- A female player in the Boys Competition can fill in for a team in the Girls competition.
 - E.g. A female player in an under 10 section 3 boys team may fill in for an under 12 (or older) Boys team from their home club, all other fill-in rules apply.
- A player registered with one club for the Girls competition may play for another club in the Boys competition, provided they have permission from their Home Club and priority is given to the Girls competition.
- To change the player's 'Home Club', clearance must be completed and submitted to WBA.
- Any player added courtside must enter their correct name and date of birth, and be registered through PlayHQ.
