All matches will be played according to the rules as stated by FIBA, the world's governing body of basketball; <u>Federation Internationale de Basketball Amateur</u>.

IMPORTANT WBA POLICIES AND DOCUMENTS

Please note that it is the team's responsibility to check schedules. Junior Club Delegates will be notified when fixtures are published, updated or amended. Clubs will endeavour to contact individual teams, but checking fixtures remains the teams' responsibility.

All participants agree to the Terms & Conditions when registering online with <u>PlayHQ</u>. This includes understanding the rules and regulations that pertain to the competition. Club officials are responsible for circulating correspondence from WBA when necessary, and ensuring accurate information is updated online through their Club Express online systems.

Where a game fee is required and not invoiced by club arrangement, representatives are responsible for paying the game fee to the doorkeeper near the entrance to each venue. This must be completed before the start of scheduled games.

Teams must complete <u>LiveScore</u> monitors with details of all players. The minimum number of players on the court without incurring a forfeit is four (4). Games will be forfeited if a team is not ready to play within ten minutes of scheduled starting time.

The <u>Waverley Basketball website</u> displays all league ladders except for the Under 8 competition, who do not compete in finals. The U/8 competition will conclude with a participation round and a medallion presentation for all players.
