In 2010 WBA launched its first Waverley TV service which was built on the back of the original Internet Explorer that used 'Silverlight' to stream games. Over time this became redundant and difficult to use across multiple systems and platforms, hence the need for this overhaul.

Over the past two years WBA's IT Developer has completely rebuilt the streaming service using HTML5, meaning you can watch your games on phones, tablets, PC's, Mac's, etc. Furthermore, the videos are also built into our website, making them easy to [find here](#)

THE WAY THE SYSTEM WORKS:

Senior Team Representatives, or Junior Club Delegates, will set up their own teams and invite others by using an invite code. This allows one person to download weekly footage but everyone who accepts the invite is able to see the video library of games.

Representatives use a password to select the game footage of date/time/court of when your match was played. This must be done within three days after your game, or the footage will disappear. Passwords will be provided to each team at the start of each season.

The footage will be ready a couple of hours after it's ordered as it needs to be downloaded, edited, and uploaded into your team lounge.
