

ENTRY AND EXIT PROCEDURES

In line with recommendations from Basketball Victoria, new conditions regarding the entry and exit paths from the Waverley Stadium have now been implemented. These procedures will also apply to all WBA run venues and courts, including primary schools and gymnasiums.

VENUES DESIGNATED ENTRIES

Players and visitors must only use the designated entries for access to all WBA run venues. The entries will remain locked during competition, and Biosecurity Officers (BSO's) will unlock and open 10 minutes prior to your scheduled game start.

WBA will close and lock all doors five minutes after games commence. The venue will remain closed until 10 minutes prior to the next scheduled game time. Please ensure you arrive within your 10-minute entry time allocation. If a player is late, a team member inside must find a BSO who will be clearly identifiable to assist any late arrivals.

At the conclusion of your match, BSO's and game officials will open the exit doors and all patrons must leave the venue via their designated exit immediately following the game, maintaining social distancing at all times. The exit doors will remain open for 10 minutes only.

Anyone with additional mobility requirements are advised to inform the BSO for safe assistance entering and exiting the facilities.


Venues used for WBA competitions will have signage available on arrival, and BSO's will assist with movement around each court. The <u>'External Venues'</u> page on WBA's website covers specific venue procedures, and the Covid Comply QR Code or website link to sign in for attendance to each court.

WAVERLEY STADIUM

At the Waverley Stadium, all patrons on courts 1/2/3 must exit through the court 3 emergency door, which leads to the Power Avenue carpark.

All patrons on courts 5/6 must exit through the court 6 emergency door, which leads to the Batesford Road carpark.

All patrons on court 4 must exit through the court 4 emergency door which leads to the Batesford Road carpark.
