



SEMI-FINALS

- 2 x 18-minute halves; Two minutes for half time
- A maximum of 1 timeout per half per team
- No timeouts in the last minute of the first half
- All Timeouts are for one minute in duration
- Clock Stops only in the last two minutes of the second half for all whistles.
- If scores are tied at the end of the second half, five minutes overtime to be played with the following rules:
 - Team fouls remain from the second half
 - Teams to continue shooting the same direction as the second half
 - One timeout per team
 - Clock stops in the last two minutes for all whistles

GRAND FINALS

- 2 x 20-minute halves; and two minutes for half time
- A maximum of two timeouts per half per team
- All Timeouts are for one minute in duration
- Clock stops in the last minute of the first half for all whistles
- Clock stops in the last two minutes of the second half for all whistles
- If scores are tied at the end of the second half, five minutes overtime to be played with the following rules:
 - Second half foul count remains
 - Teams to continue shooting the same direction as the second half
 - One timeout per team
 - Clock stops in the last two minutes for all whistles
